The Africa Prize for Engineering Innovation awards commercialisation support to African innovators developing scalable engineering solutions to local challenges. Each year, a cohort of up to 16 are selected from across sub-Saharan Africa to participate in eight months of training and mentoring, culminating in a final where the winner is awarded £25,000.

Winner, 2022: Norah Magero Innovation: Vaccibox

Mechanical engineer, Norah Magero and her team developed VacciBox, a small, mobile, solar-powered fridge that safely stores and transports temperature-sensitive medicines such as vaccines, for use in field vaccinations and in off-grid hospitals.

"I've grown immensely and met such brilliant engineers and nonengineers doing amazing things through the Africa Prize. This award will help us continue to develop Vaccibox to help get life-saving vaccines to many more people."
