The EEA Ghana is a National Award honouring the outstanding contribution of an individual or organization to promoting engineering excellence and innovations and engineering students showing great potential for research. The fifth EEA event, will be presented in **May 2020** in Accra, Ghana. The 2019 Awards expand the scope by seeking to encourage Engineering Research, Engineering Evangelism and the study of Engineering Subjects by young people. This initiative is brought to life by the introduction of new categories as well as the expansion of existing ones. The General public is encouraged to participate in this prestigious and increasingly competitive award.

All nominations for the 2019 EEA, Ghana, will be examined by a Panel of Assessors. Nominations are opened from **4th March, 2020** to **5th May, 2020**. The nomination form and all accompanying materials must be submitted in English. Information about the nominee should be provided as accurately as possible on the nomination form.

Call for Nominations 2019/2020 Engineering Excellence Awards, Ghana

The Categories for Nominations

1. PRACTITIONERS CATEGORY

RESEARCH & ACADEMIC CATEGORY (2 AWARDS)

For an individual/group who has made an outstanding contribution to Public benefit through innovative, research for solving a problem.

ENGINEERING CONCEPTS AND INNOVATIONS (1 Award)

For an engineer, individual/group, that have demonstrated engineering excellence in concept development, economic consideration, environmental impact, social impact and sustainability.

ENGINEERING MANAGEMENT (1 Award)

For an engineer, individual/group or organisation that have demonstrated engineering excellence in planning, leadership achievement, organization, commitment to health and safety issues.

IMPLEMENTATION OF ENGINEERING SOLUTIONS (1 Award)

For an engineer, individual/group, that have demonstrated engineering excellence in achieving of original intent, local content participation, efficient use of resources, impact on society and environment, engineering innovation and outstanding quality, and commitment to health and safety issues.

DISTINGUISHED WOMAN IN ENGINEERING (1 AWARD)

For a female engineer who has shown an exemplary achievements in her professional Engineering practice.

2. STUDENTS AND YOUNG INNOVATORS CATEGORIES

INNOVATION: APPLIED SCIENCE & MATHEMATICS -JHS and SHS (4 Awards)

For students, individual/group, in the Public and Private Second Cycle and Basic levels of Education in Ghana; for an innovative and relevant project.

OUTSTANDING ENGINEERING KNOWLEDGE & EXEMPLARY ACHIEVEMENT (2 Awards)

For a young engineer (not more than the age of 35 by April 30, 2020) for his/her exemplary achievements and demonstration of potential in the engineering profession.

3. PUBLIC SERVICE CATEGORY

PUBLIC AWARDS (2 Awards)

For individual/group, that has made substantial contributions to the promoting of engineering practice and/or increasing public understanding of engineering. This Award is specifically meant for non-engineers.

ENGINEERING EVANGELISM (1 Award)

For individual/group media practitioners, that has made substantial contributions to the promoting of engineering practice and/or increasing public awareness or the understanding of engineering.
