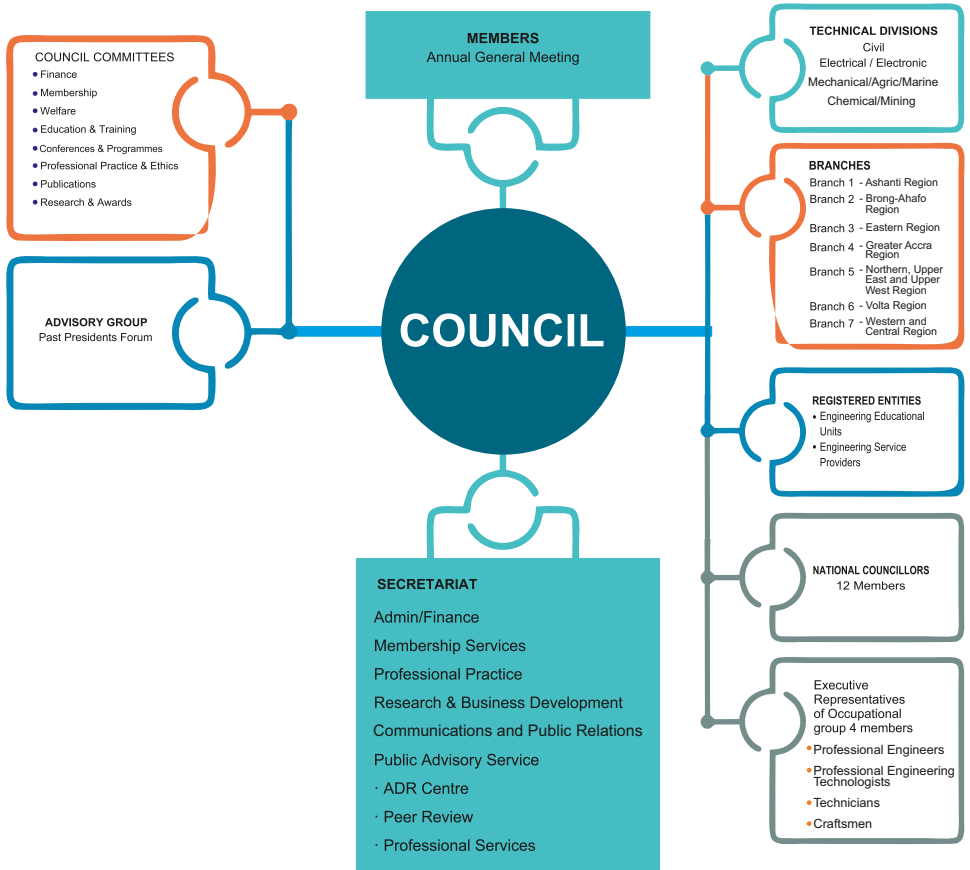

Ghana Institution of Engineering (GhIE) was officially founded in 1968 to promote quality engineering practice in Ghana comparable to global standards. The GhIE is the professional body which is responsible for the certification of engineering practitioners (Professional Engineers, Professional Engineering Technologists, Engineering Technicians and Engineering Craftsmen) prior to registration with the Engineering Council of Ghana. The GhIE derives its authority from the Professional Bodies Decree NRCD 143, 1973 and the Engineering Council Act, 2011 (Act 819). In 1999, Women in Engineering (WinE) was founded to attract more females into the profession.

The GhIE ensures that practitioners in the Engineering industry maintain professional standards, adhere to regulations, guidelines and codes of ethics of engineering practice by conforming to internationally established technical, environmental and safety standards.

The GhIE represents about 14,404 registered professionals who are spread over four main technical divisions namely CIVIL, ELECTRICAL, MECHANICAL and CHEMICAL. Emerging engineering disciplines such as Robotics, Specialized Marine, Aviation and Aerospace, Biomedical, Renewable Energy, Oil & Gas, etc. are each situated under one of the four Technical Divisions.

GhIE collaborates with the government (ministries, departments, agencies, district assemblies) and private sector (Built Environment Professionals) to enhance institutional practice in the built environment sector.
